Club Policy on the use and control of CCTV cameras

Purpose of Cameras

The cameras are for use by club members only for the safe keeping of their boats and for monitoring the river levels in the event of floods.

The camping areas of the club are not covered by the cameras to ensure privacy of members.

Storage of still images

Images are automatically taken by the cameras on a timed basis and by detection of movement. These are stored for a period of 3 days on the clubs web site before being deleted.

The storage is used to enable members without the equipment to view live images, to see the current state of the river and monitor their boats .

Images are taken each hour and on motion detection Monday to Friday 6am to 6pm

Security

Access to the images stored on the web site is controlled.

Images stored on the web site are deleted after 3 days.

The sound recording facility is disabled on ALL cameras

Any face recognition is disabled

Where possible, public areas are avoided for motion detection and areas masked off

Access to the cameras settings is controlled.

Members are informed not to record any images or video from the cameras and instructions are held in the "New Members Handbook"

NO VIDEO RECORDINGS ARE STORED BY THE CLUB. MEMBERS ARE REQUESTED NOT TO RECORD ANY VIDEOS SEEN THROUGH ANY CAMERA AS THIS COULD BREAK DATA PROTECTION LAWS.
