



Avon Sailing Club Dog on Site Policy

Please read this policy carefully as it explains the terms on which you may bring a dog on to Avon Sailing Club (ASC) premises. The behaviour of dogs should not negatively impact our members or visitors.

1. ASC welcomes dogs of members that comply with the rules set out in this policy.
2. Dogs are allowed on site at the absolute discretion of ASC.
3. Owners are expected to hold a current, 3rd Party insurance policy covering their dog for damage or injury for a minimum of £2,000,000. Any damage caused by your dog will need to be paid for by you.
4. Dogs are not to be left unattended unless in a car, caravan or similar secure location. Dogs must not be left in tents or awnings unattended.
5. Dogs must be kept on a lead of no more than 2 m when with their owner and kept under control at all times.
6. No dogs (except assistance dogs) are permitted in the Clubhouse.
7. No dogs are permitted in the safety boat.
8. You are fully responsible for your dog at all times and for cleaning up after your dog. All dog waste must be cleared up immediately and disposed of appropriately.
9. If your dog is deemed to be a nuisance or danger to other ASC members or visitors, we have the right to request you remove the dog from the site. When bringing a new dog on site, the owner should advise other members as to its temperament with humans and other dogs.
10. We do not accept liability for any loss, injury or illness to a dog.
11. Dogs are expected to be fully vaccinated, micro-chipped and with a collar identifying the owner.
12. Violations of the above rules will be reviewed by the Committee. Appropriate sanctions may be applied to the dog and the owner could face disciplinary action as defined by the Committee.
